The Permanent Mission of the Republic of Azerbaijan to the United Nations Office and other International Organizations in Geneva presents its compliments to the Permanent Delegation of the Organization of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) to the United Nations Office in Geneva, and has the honour to inform that the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan H.F. Mr. Ilham Aliyev has signed an Order to set up scholarships for citizens of the OIC Member States who want to study at higher education institutions in Azerbaijan.

Under the order, scholarships will be available for citizens of the OIC Member States to pursue undergraduate, graduate, doctoral, basic medical and medical residency degrees. The five-year program will see allocation of a total of 100 scholarships with 20 scholarships per year starting from 2018. Scholarships will cover tuition fees, visa, registration, accommodation, daily meal expenses, transportation (excluding taxi), utility bills, any required study materials, insurance and a return ticket once a year at the expense of the Government of Azerbaijan.
